

WORLD [AT] SCHOOL

The Flemish department of Education and Training and Study in Flanders implemented the World@School-project starting in the academic year 2017-2018. The project aims to promote internationalisation in primary and secondary schools.

Each international student at a Flemish higher education institution can participate in the World@School-project. Both students who stay in Flanders for a short or long period of time are eligible. The nationality of the student is not taken into account either.

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Description

The World@School-project brings international students from Flemish universities and universities of applied sciences and arts in contact with primary and/or secondary schools. As a student you can participate by giving a presentation or workshop about local habits and customs, general topics, language, music, etc. The theme of the activity is determined by the student and the school in mutual agreement. After the activity, the international student will receive a financial compensation by VLUHR-i.

Modalities

PHYSICAL EVENT

A fixed amount for the first 2 sessions:

Solo presentation: € 50,00 Duo presentation: € 70,00

A top-up of € 15,00 per additional session of the same activity.

For example: if you give three sessions of a solo presentation, you will be financially compensated with an amount of €65.

VIRTUAL EVENT

A fixed amount for the first 2 sessions:

Solo presentation: € 30,00 Duo presentation: € 50,00

A top-up of € 15,00 per additional session of the same activity.

For example: if you give three sessions of a solo presentation, you will be financially compensated with an amount of €45.

Procedure

The student sends in application via the application form on the website.

Interested schools can invite students based on the anonymous applications.

The student and the school discuss the topic(s) and date(s) of the presentation.

The student will give a session(s) at the school and completes the performance sheet.

Based on the performance sheet, VLUHR-i will issue the payment to the student.
